Why train laboratory animals?

- √ Creates less stressful environment
- ✓Increases compliance
- ✓Increases welfare
- √ Plays a role in EU directive






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

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Target audience:



Aim:

Improve and facilitate ABM & PRT and animal welfare by creating opportunities to acquire needed skills and creating a well-connected and sharing community of trainers of large laboratory animals

primTRAIN Workgroups

WG Providing (Scientific Evidence)

Objectives: Collect relevant scientific references and make them available.

Tasks & Milestones:

- Compilation of a central catalogue of literature relevant for ABM/NHP training;
- Selection and discussion of the most important papers on ABM/NHP training;
- Selecting basic readings for beginners

Deliverables:

- Virtual Journal Clubs: Selected articles on ABM/PRT (webinars)
- Workshop: Scientific evidence on the (economic) success of PRT and ABM
- Catalogue of literature references about PRT/ABM
- Provide a selection of basic readings for beginners
- Annual WG meeting

WG Increasing (Competence)

 Objectives: provide in-house and online lectures on different topics of training, ABM and Animal Welfare Science, as well as educate staff on ABM/NHP training.

• Tasks & Milestones:

- Visiting primate facilities and provide lectures & consulting tailored to needs of staff and facility
- Workshop & training schools

Deliverables:

- In-house lectures/webinars;
- Workshop ("Teaching ABM/Laboratory NHP/animal Training")
- (two) Training schools on ABM/NHP training
- Annual WG meeting

WG Increasing (Competence)

 Objectives: Provide an exchange platform, which allows for safe and detailed communication about issues concerning the training of NHP and promotes the **sharing of information and knowledge**, such as training protocols, as well as developing new training protocols.

Tasks & Milestones:

- Sharing of knowledge and experiences through exchange of training protocols.
- Development of new protocols and discussion of their success.
- Implementation of a platform for the exchange of training protocols and for regular communication between members beyond the annual meetings

Deliverables:

- Web meetings 1-2x/yearWorkshop: NHP Training Protocols
- Annual WG meeting

WG Communicating (ABM, PRT, Animal Welfare)

• <u>Objectives</u>: In this work group communication strategies will be elaborated to address different target audiences, lab animal staff may get confronted with.

Furthermore this WG will determine the status quo in terms of ABM/lab animal training in European NHP facilities. Based on the result, a **minimum standard for ABM/lab animal training will be defined**, including recommendations beyond the requirements of Directive 2010/ 63/EC.

• Tasks & Milestones:

- Analysing the different situations at the European primate centres
- Develop recommendations regarding a minimum European standard on NHP training
- Elaborating arguments useful in the debate on ABM/NHP training

• Deliverables:

- Workshop: Communication strategies for different target audiences;
- Workshop: Arguments pro ABM/lab animal training/animal welfare/animal research;
- White paper: Recommendations regarding a minimum European standard on NHP/lab animal training
- Annual WG meetings

In Addition

Short term scientific missions

- opportunitiy for animal facility staff, doctoral students,
 postodoctoral fellows to visit another facility (between 5 90 days)
 with the purpose of learning ABM/PRT techniques
- application possible once per year
- selection carried out by STSM coordinator

Dissemination Activities

- Events (e.g. Webinars, Training Schools) disseminated through emails, posters via mail list & posted on relevant websites
- dedicated webpage
